

Many headaches for morning commuters

NEW HAVEN, Conn. (WTNH) – No matter what major highway you were on, there seemed to be an accident Thursday morning that slowed the morning commute to a crawl.

In New Haven, a crash between a car and truck, and another stalled vehicle. On I-95 North at the turn into the Long wharf area slowed the already busy morning drive. That happened a little before 7:00 a.m.

"i95 north is a parking lot from the i91/i95 merge all the way back to Milford," Robert Roy told News 8 via Twitter.

That in turn caused other headaches.

"route one from Orange to New Haven crawling....," Jeff Cap said on Twitter.

"Merritt NB NH/Hamden solid backup down hill & into the tunnel!," Rachael Klotzberger said in Twitter. The Merritt was also slowed by a crash at Exit 62.

There was another big accident in East Hartford. Four lanes of I-84 westbound were closed at Exit 56 because of a crash involving a tractor trailer and as many as five other vehicles. That happened a little before 8:00 a.m.

In Waterbury, I-84 eastbound was backed up more than six miles at one point because of a tractor trailer crash between Exits 25 and 25A. The truck went off the road into the woods.
